

From the pastor's desk,

This month I want to remind all of us of our individual responsibility to the church. Recently I have asked for help in certain areas of need within our church ministries. Some have stepped forward, but not nearly as many as should have. In one request, I did not receive any responses. I know we are all busy people. We must be careful not to assume someone else will do it, especially when we are well able and available to do it ourselves. For the next few months in my newsletter article, I plan on addressing our responsibility to one another as a church family.

This month let's start with the basic responsibility of showing up. Our by-laws say that we are to be faithful "to habitually attend the services of this church". This is not a suggestion or just empty words, this is one of the duties of membership in a local church. But it is more than that. We are instructed in God's Word not to forsake the assembling of ourselves together.

Hebrews 10:23-25 (NASB95)

23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful;

24 and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds,

25 not forsaking our own assembling together, as it is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

We have a responsibility to regularly attend the worship services of this church. Notice that the Bible says there are some who have developed the habit of not attending. Habits once developed are often hard to break. If any of you who are reading this article have developed the habit of being absent from church gatherings, unless providentially prevented I hope you understand that God tells you to be here. It is good for you and it is good for the rest of us. May the Lord help us all to obey his instruction and to fulfill our duty as members of Buck Grove by showing up.

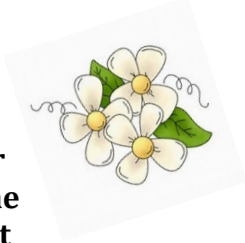
Meet at the church at 11:15 on Saturday
